# Marie Curie Conferences and Training Courses

Scientific conferences and courses are effective ways of learning, exchanging information and planning future projects. Marie Curie funding is available to help universities, research centres and businesses in the EU or Associated States organise conferences and training courses and to allow early-stage and more experienced researchers to take part.

The research organisation submits a proposal to the Commission to fund either a series of events or a large conference. The Commission then selects the most relevant proposals and signs a contract with the organisers.

In the case of series of events, support is given towards the organisational costs and the participation of early-stage researchers (in the first four years of their career) and experienced researchers (with up to ten years' experience) of all nationalities. This includes European researchers working outside the EU or Associated States.

In the case of large conferences, support is provided by the Commission to allow early-stage and experienced researchers to take part. All nationalities are eligible, except for events outside the EU or Associated States. In this case, only EU and candidate country researchers are eligible.

The last [call for proposals](#) has been published on 19 January 2005. Next deadline: 18 May 2005.
